European project to help people from rural areas

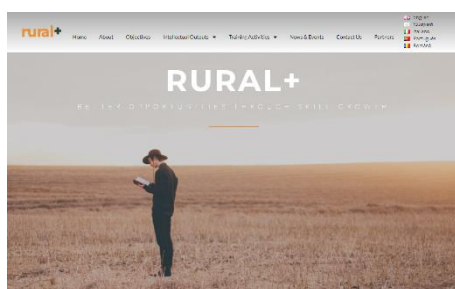
The first days of February, brought the conclusion of IO2 (Creation of the learning materials) activities of the Rural+ project.

At the end of December, the English version of the Learning Materials have been finalized. Partners delivered the content of three learning courses, namely:

- Business Etiquette (BE)
- Learning How to Learn (LHL)
- Professional Digital Literacy (PDL)

Additionally, a complete guide (Trainer's Kit) have been designed, in order to assist youth trainers VET educators as well as any interested training provider in their work.

Partners have now also concluded the translation of the materials for the three courses and as soon as they are ready, they will be uploaded on project's website (<https://ruralplus.net/>).



The developed learning courses, combining ad hoc educational approaches, provide a complete training package to VET learners concerning collateral skills that are required in the job searching process and further on in their professional development.

Subsequently those learning materials will be compiled to e-learning materials, transformed to suitable formats, in order to be hosted at **Rural+** e-platform (<https://ruralpluslearning.net/>)

The e-learning platform is dedicated to the support of the learning materials and constitutes the base of learning for both, VET educators and the VET learners.



The project is funded by Erasmus +, the program of European Commission promoting the development of education in Europe, and is focused on training people from rural areas to get the skills and competences needed for the labour market.
